1. Applications/information on nominated students must reach the receiving institution by:

2. The receiving institution will send its decision within [4] weeks.
3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. *[It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]*
4. Termination of the agreement

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1

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September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]

1. Grading systems of the institutions

5 = sufficient;

6 = satisfactory;

7-8 = good;

9 = very good;

10 = excellent.

The maximum final university grade is 10.

Language courses and laboratories are usually graded as "Approved", if passed.

ECTS credits:

1 full academic year = 60 credits

1 semester = 30 credits

ECTS Grading scale:

ECTS Grade	% of successful students normally achieving the grade	Definition
A	10	EXCELLENT - outstanding performance with only minor errors
B	9	VERY GOOD - above the average standard but with some errors
C	7-8	GOOD - generally sound work with a number of notable errors
D	6	SATISFACTORY - fair but with significant shortcomings
E	5	SUFFICIENT - performance meets the minimum criteria


