

#### 5. Finances

Please note that applicants need to allow for about CHF 1'500.- to 2'000.- per month for living costs. Students can only apply for a student working permit allowing them to work for a max. of 15 hours per week once they have officially resided in Switzerland for 6 months.

#### 6. Health and accident insurance

In Switzerland having a health insurance is compulsory. Students holding a European Health Insurance Card as well as persons whose health insurance schemes are recognized by the Swiss authorities can apply to become exempt from the duty to take out health insurance.
