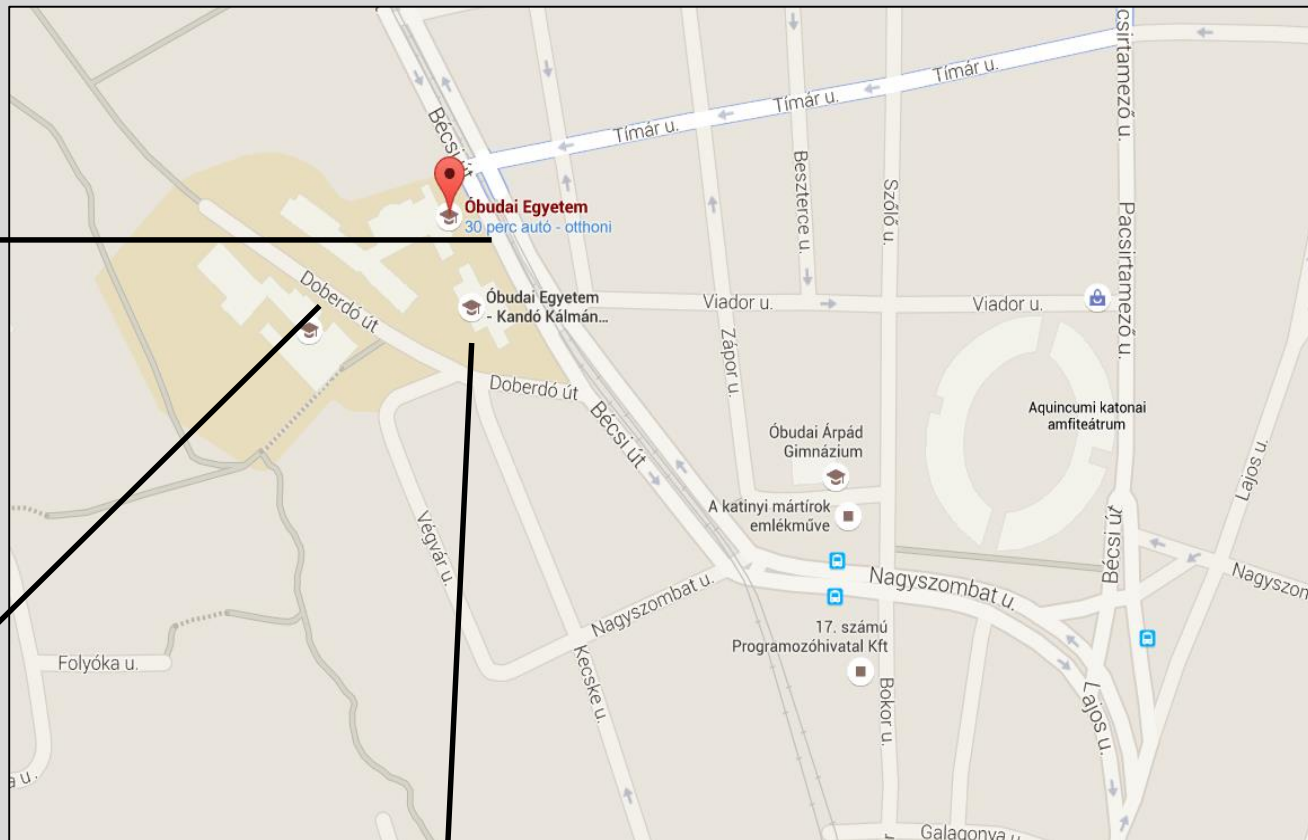

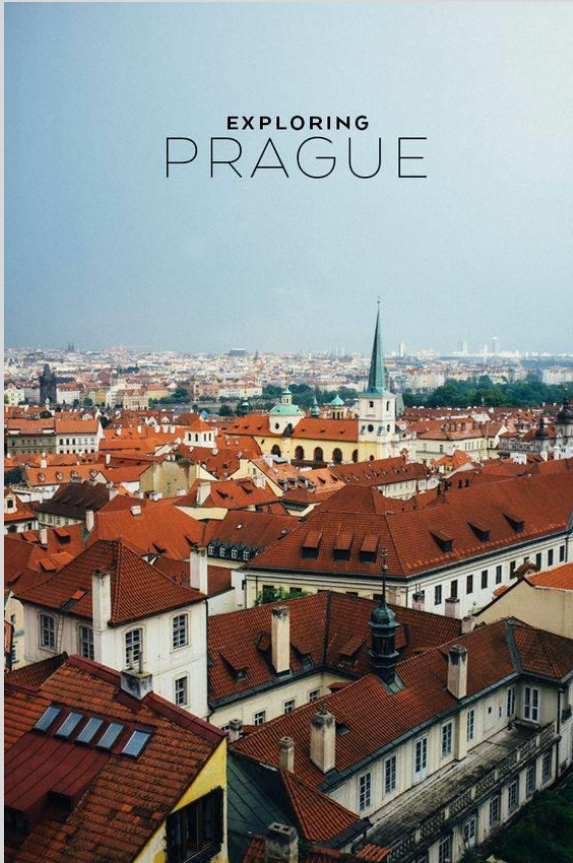
Fröccs is 1dl soda with 1dl wine, it's tasty, cools you down in summer, and warms you up in winter.
