



Krakow and Auschwitz Concentration Camp Trip

The trip will start in Opole on Thursday 26th, after departure we will be heading to Auschwitz where the Nazi concentration camp is located. Auschwitz is a network of concentration and extermination camps built and operated by the Third Reich in Polish areas annexed by Nazi Germany during World War II. It was the largest of the German concentration camps, consisting of Auschwitz I, Auschwitz II–Birkenau, Auschwitz III–Monowitz, and 45 satellite camps. After 2-hour guided tour (in English) we will be heading to Krakow.

After arrival to Krakow we will check into one of the hostels in the city centre. At 7 pm we are planning to have an official dinner in one of best known Krakow restaurants.

Next day in the morning we are planning to have a short guided tour around the city and its most interesting sites such as Wawel Royal Castle, Kazimierz district and St. Mary's Church.

In the afternoon we will get back to Opole.
