- **HU BUDAPES16:** A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than four weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- **D HILDESH02:** A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than five weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

The involved institutions agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the interinstitutional agreement. In the event of termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."
