D. Additional requirements

BG SOFIA30

The Bulgarian Academy of Sciences is entitled to teach PhD students (3rd level) and not Master of Bachelor students. Incoming students may attend courses at any of the 42 institutes of the Academy as long as they correspond to their field of study and there is a group to begin a course. Students with disabilities may only be admitted after consultation with the Erasmus office.

HU BUDAPES16

- 1 Exchange students will meet the admission requirements of the host university in terms of prerequisites for courses and language proficiency.
- 2 The host university will provide Welcome Orientation Week for incoming students.
- 3 Exchange students are entitled to the same rights and privileges as students normally enrolled at the host university, except for the right for graduation.
- 4 The host university will comply with all relevant health and safety regulations of the host country for incoming exchange students.

- 6. All documents must be sent by e-mail (incoming@uni-obuda.hu). No hard copies are needed.
- 7. Óbuda University sends by mail notification on admission automatically within 5 weeks. Óbuda University sends Acceptance Letters, Registration Form, Info sheet to all accepted students.

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
