Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of conflict. The Agreement may be terminated by either Party providing sixty (60) days advance written notice to the other Party. In the case of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. The Agreement may be extended or amended by mutual consent of the Parties.
