- 1) The signed form should be sent by e-mail together with the compulsory attachement:
 - a) Learning Agreement
 - b) Transcript of records of the home university (in English)
 - c) Motivation letter (only in case of project or diploma work)
 - d) Health nsurrance (latest upon the arrival)
 - e) Obligatory confirmation of the home institution
 - f) Certificate of language exam
 - g) A copy of identity card or international passport
 - h) CV with passport-sized photo
- 2) Please all documents mentioned above to scan and send by email to the following address: **incoming@uni-obuda.hu**
- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 6 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

A notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
