When **HU BUDAPEST16** is the receiving institution:

- 1. Link to the application forms: hhtp://erasmus.uni-obuda.hu/en/forms
- 2. All documents must be sent by e-mail (incoming@uni-obuda.hu). No hard copies are needed.
- Óbuda University sends by mail notification on admission automatically within 5 weeks.
 Óbuda University sends Acceptance Letter, Registration Form and Info Sheet to all accepted students.
- 4. The host university will issue a Transcript of Records no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished.

When **SK KOSICE02** is the receiving institution:

The receiving institution will send its decision within [4] weeks.

A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than [5] weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]

Termination of the agreement

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]
