- VFU recommends checking and being sure for the instruction language/ECTS/hours of the relevant course(s) through Erasmus Coordinator at International Affairs and Projects Office or Erasmus Departmental Coordinators of the relevant faculty.
- VFU has the infrastructure to welcome students and staff with disabilities
- The mother tongue at VFU is Bulgarian. If Erasmus students has sufficient knowledge in Bulgarian language they could enroll for all subject offered in the degree programme for his/her subject area.
- All students who have level B1 in English language could follow the offered English courses for 30 ECTS in every subject area.
- To all students is given the possibility to study in English, according to the subject area in which the student is enrolled
- In all department courses in English language are taught during the winter semester of each academic year.

This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Students selected prior the date of notification must be admitted by the receiving institution. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
